The client is a privately owned company producing small tools and industrial products for both industrial and retail customers. Located in the Northern Suburbs of Melbourne and also in the Regional Victoria the client produces and manages over 17,000 stock keeping units (SKU's) at sites all over Victoria. With major customers in both the retail and trade segments the client was experiencing major growth in a range of areas.

The predominant role within this task was to redesign the current distribution centre layout taking into consideration future growth patterns, productivity improvements and facility constraints. The process involved a staged approach which included;

- Data collection
- Data analysis
- Facility design
- Facility planning
- Capital budgeting

The process was undertaken over a 6 month period encompassing not only the abovementioned tasks but also larger supply chain issues including transport. The project is still currently underway with completion expected in February 2004.
